Doug is most comfortable in a kitchen. He's been a professional cook for 45 years; finding work was rarely a problem for him. But there were hard times in Doug's life – like when his marriage ended in divorce, and when his brother was killed. Alcoholism ran in Doug's family, and he, too, used it to cope.

"There was a lot of self-loathing... blaming myself. I felt I couldn't do anything right, so I buried myself in drinking. I lost my job," he shares.

Doug came to the Mission a few times, but each time he soon found a job and moved out. But then his addiction would take over, and Doug would come back. He didn't stay long enough to address the root of his problem – until God intervened.

"One time I was at the Mission, and I could not find a job – no matter how hard I tried. That's when I realized God wanted me to stay," he says. "I started paying attention during Bible studies after that."

It was hard for Doug to open up about his past at first. He lacked confidence. But when he was put in charge of our kitchen, that changed. By getting back to what he loved – cooking and serving others – he found himself again.

"I started to relate to others and share my witness about how drinking affected me. A lot of us are going through the same thing."

Doug has been our head chef for four years, and he still loves his job. A large portion of the food served at the Mission is donated, so Doug doesn't know what ingredients will come through the door each day. He has to be creative, and that excites him.

With Jesus' love in his heart and hope for the future, Doug is grateful for your support this Easter. "I'm thankful for the family here and I just want to do right by the Lord."

"I felt the Holy Spirit talking to me. I felt the twinge of conviction and realized God wants me here."
