

"The Mission increased my quality of life. And NOW | HAVE HOPE."

Olt was in the hospital, and he wasn't sure how he got there. He was a type one diabetic, and he hadn't taken care of himself. Now, he'd had a stroke. He couldn't even remember where he lived. His life had always been unstable, but now it had fallen apart.

"I could never get a foothold in life," he shares. "I moved around a lot living with other people. But I was secluded, a loner."

Though Colt felt completely alone, Union Gospel Mission of Grays Harbor was familiar.

He'd met the staff during a time of homelessness. Now, they were his only option.

"I wandered around trying to find anything that would excite me to live. The only place I knew to go was the Mission."

Colt came here looking for safety and stability. But he was also hoping for a sign from God. Colt was not a believer, but he arrived at the Mission open to exploring his faith.

Colt's hope for meaning materialized through the Mission. For the first time, he had structure and responsibilities. He healed physically and emotionally, and he started taking control of his life and his health. He developed a work ethic. And he discovered a love for helping others.

"

I wasn't spiritual, but I started going to church every weekend. The Mission gave me hope that I could find meaning for my life.

"It excites me to see other people change their attitude for good, to be happy," he says. "I didn't really do much living before coming to the Mission, but I actually want to live now."

Colt has a plan for his life. He's moved out of the Mission to be with his family, and he still attends church regularly. He hopes to attend college and study social work.



Colt's heart is overflowing with gratitude this Thanksgiving because YOUR loving support gave him the confidence and support to rebuild his life. "This is a place that gave me a foothold to get back into the world. It really strengthened me... it's been quite wonderful."
