



Athy remembers a tough childhood: her parents both worked at an auto plant and her dad had a drinking problem. Eventually, the family fell apart, and Kathy was out on her own as a teenaged wife and mother.

Determined to have a better life, Kathy and her husband stayed involved with their church. "I called myself the perfect Christian wife," she remembers, but her faith faltered when their marriage ended due to her husband's infidelity.

A few years later, with her two daughters in tow, Kathy moved cross-country to be with her new husband. Twenty years and three children later, her life felt complete. Then, her world was turned upside down by his unexpected passing.

All her life, she'd focused on her children while depending on her partners to deal with bills and paperwork. "I was always 'Mom,' but I didn't know how to take care of myself," Kathy admits.

She began to fall in with people who didn't have her best interest at heart, and she came to the realization that she could lose everything. Thankfully, she found a nearby Crisis Center where a kind staff member led her to Union Gospel Mission of Grays Harbor.

At Friendship House, Kathy found stability and safety. As she settled in with the other women, she began sleeping more soundly and even learned to smile again. She was asked to join the program, and she committed to a new life of learning through God's Word.

With classes, Bible study and a structured environment, Kathy has learned to be independent. She's made friends, and gives back by sharing her time and talents. "I love helping the ladies who come here. The Mission runs a tight ship that works!"

Kathy has hope this Christmas – and she wants to thank YOU for supporting her journey toward a new life. "With the Lord by my side, I know that wherever I am is exactly where I need to be."
